The Wessex Basketball Association is running a Level 2 Referee course over two days and candidates need to attend both days.

Sunday 22 May 9-5pm Wellington Health and fitness centre, Crowthorne, RG45 7PT

The course is being tutored by NBL Referee and Basketball England Tutor Ian Lester.

This course is aimed at those with either a level 1 qualification or reasonable basketball experience. This qualification allows the successful candidate to officiate local league, age group and central venue basketball.

There will be a mix of theory, general practice, full game practice and a rules test. Candidates will need to pass both the theory and the rules test (but rest assured all questions will be covered adequately during the coursework!!).

The fee for this course is £40 but our aim is to grow the Wessex Area pool of active officials and therefore the course fee will be refunded in full to candidates once they have successfully completed the course which includes refereeing 3 matches.

The minimum age for participants is 16 years.

Morning Ruth,

I made some enquires about the course process, so for the level 1 we need to get as many people as possible to complete the level 1 course online then we can run the practical assessment at no cost to your club. If we run a face to face level 2 then we will have to provide a venue and tutor fees, but if we apply with more then 6 students then we get a 50% reduction which will help to pay the costs.

For a face to face course we would require a classroom with IT (PowerPoint) for about a day and half and then a 4 hour practical session in a gym.

Hope that makes more sense.
