Return to Play 2021

On March 2nd the Government issued guidance that mapped a route out of lockdown due to the Covid-19 pandemic.

Basketball England subsequently issued guidance for the staged resumption of basketball activities that conform to the Governments guidance – see <https://www.basketballengland.co.uk/safeguarding/return-to-play-guidance/> .

It is Woking Blackhawks intention to follow to Basketball England Guidance, the significant stages and dates that impact on the activities of the Club are tabulated below. The Youth and Senior sections will decide when to recommence sessions based on the dates below and members will be advised accordingly.

Wheelchair sessions will recommence in accordance guidance from the British Wheelchair Basketball Association

19 th July	Return to Play measures removed (Enhanced hygiene measures may be required)	Return to Play measures removed. (Enhanced hygiene measures may be required)

- Screening at sessions will continue, records kept and returned to the Covid Officer – the Proactive Online Resource is still available. .
- Any Incidents of Covid identified must be reported to Basketball England. Affected persons must isolate in accordance with guidance
- Hygiene/sanitizing actions must continue during sessions
